Professional Conduct and Participation

I commit to conducting myself in a manner that reflects the values and standards of Nomad Guide School. This includes:

- Showing respect toward fellow participants, instructors, assessors, and support staff at all times.
- Taking an active role in both individual and group learning tasks, contributing constructively to the team.
- Maintaining a professional attitude in all aspects of fieldwork, classroom learning, and camp life.
- Using English as the main language of communication during lessons, assessments, and activities.
- Avoiding behavior that disrupts the group dynamic, training schedule, or the overall learning atmosphere.
- Taking proper care of all training materials, equipment, and facilities, and respecting property belonging to NGS or partner organizations.

Responsibility for Property and Safety

I understand that participation in field-based training carries inherent risks. I will act responsibly to ensure my safety and that of others, and I will respect all operational and safety guidelines.

If I cause damage to NGS vehicles, property, or equipment through negligence or misuse, I accept responsibility for the cost of repair or replacement. I also understand that I may take out personal insurance to cover such situations.

• Integrity and Ethical Behavior

I recognize that honesty, reliability, and discretion are essential traits of a professional guide. I therefore commit to:

- Acting truthfully and transparently in all matters relating to my qualifications, performance, and conduct.
- Protecting confidential information and operational procedures shared by NGS or its partners.
- Upholding ethical standards toward wildlife, people, and the environment.
- Avoiding any form of harassment, coercion, or exploitation, whether verbal, physical, or sexual.

Substance Use and Fitness to Participate

I understand that participation under the influence of alcohol or mind-altering substances is prohibited.

Any behavior that compromises safety, learning quality, or the wellbeing of others as a result of substance use constitutes grounds for disciplinary action or dismissal.

Grounds for Dismissal

I acknowledge that Nomad Guide School may terminate my participation, without refund and with immediate effect, if I:

- Engage in theft, fraud, or misappropriation of property.
- Commit acts of violence, intimidation, or deliberate harm.
- Willfully damage property or equipment.
- Refuse to comply with safety rules, instructions, or reasonable directions from NGS staff.
- Offer, solicit, or accept bribes, or behave in any way that undermines integrity or trust.
- Exhibit any conduct deemed unethical, dangerous, or incompatible with the standards of NGS.
- Engage in any behavior that compromises safety, learning quality, or the wellbeing of others as a result of substance use

If termination occurs, I accept responsibility for arranging and paying for my own transport and departure from the training area.

professionalism. I will approach challenges with a positive and proactive attitude, contribute
to a supportive group environment, and uphold the reputation of Nomad Guide School in all
my actions.
